If you find produce going bad in the box at time of pickup please inform us at the farm within 48 hours. We will have plastic bags available at the site as well.

If you have been referenced by a new member you will both receive a 5% rebate at the beginning of the season. To defer rebate please inform us that you are donating to the farm the 5%.
